Purpose

The Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA) is the global professional body for public finance professionals and recognises practitioners at every level, from those starting out in their career to those innovating and leading the profession. Scope

This policy is aimed at internal CIPFA staff, our members and students.

Rationale for packaging
