





Example - Radio Button Table



An extension of the Radio Button question type. A multiple-choice question which accepts one answer only. Allows for the presentation of the answers in tabular form, with the student selecting one correct row/option.




Example - Radio Button Matrix



Another extension of the Radio Button question type. A multiple-choice question which accepts multiple answers. Allows for the presentation in tabular form, with the student select one option in each row, across one row or multiple rows. Helpful for allocating a list of items to a category and marking multiple statements as True or False. Also known as a Rating or Scale question.

Example - Check Box Matrix

A multiple-choice question which accepts multiple answers. Similar in principle to the Radio Button Matrix. In this case the student can select one or more options in each row. There may be one row or multiple rows, subject to the question design.



Example - Drag and Drop



The same intuitive dragging method as Ranking, but with functionality to add further options and/or categories. Good for both simple drag and System drop questions and more complex ranking or categorisation of options.






Example – Essay




Offering the student a similar experience to a TextArea question, with a single text area window in which to write. Unlike TextArea, the Essay question type allows for separate scoring for different parts of the question from an examiner standpoint. Set up is similar to the Spreadsheet question type, with creation of Sub-Questions to enable the correct marking scheme for the question.

Rogo's 'Spreadsheet Workings' function






Spreadsheet style questions – December 2023



Good for questions requiring a spreadsheet emulator, offering core spreadsheet and some accountancy functions. Admins can upload a spreadsheet template to be used as a starting point for the student if required. Requires the addition of a Sub-Question in order to add marks.

Calculator	Use the Calculator button to undertake calculations, or check your manual calculations. Workings on the calculator are not saved or marked in a final exam.
Reading Ruler	Click on the Reading Ruler , to launch Rogo's pop-up ruler. This can be dragged across the screen to hover beneath the question text, to support you in navigating to a key line or paragraph.
✔ Note Pad	Use the Note Pad function to jot down rough notes as you work through a paper. Content within the note pad is not saved or marked.
■ Spreadsheet Workings	Click on the Spreadsheet Workings button to launch an Excel-style, spreadsheet emulator. As you navigate through the paper, your work will be saved. For human-marked practice tests and exams, spreadsheet workings may be viewed by trainers or examiners, however they will not be marked unless pasted into your answer window.
