Main points from CIPFA Council Meeting 16/1/2020

1. We received the final version of CIPFA's Business Plan and the annual budget for 2020.

Points to note:

- Revenue growth in 2019 was up 10% with an expected surplus of £519k
- Higher than anticipated numbers of new apprentices
- Savings realised on staff restructures
- Plan will be published on website and can be circulated to regions
- Question was asked how the 2020 Plan fits with regional development plans response was that themes correspond to what regions have been advised already
- 2020 Financial position looks much more stable with the planned surplus of £218k.
- 2. Diversity and Inclusion Strategy
- A working group has been established with representatives from pan-public sector
- Regional representatives are encouraged to join to be champion D&I at local level Regional Councils are asked to help identify volunteers – Contact Drew Cullen for details
- 3. Member Nominations Committee is being established of CPFA qualified senior CIPFA staff moving away from the admissions previously considered by Students and Members Board.
