Budget vs actual

The outturn prediction is to broadly come in on budget overall. This is dependent on the final position of the annual dinner but at the moment, we expect it to breakeven and this assumption has been made in the predicted outturn.

Debtors

All 2022 debtors have paid, except one invoice from the dinner for £172.50 which we don't foresee any problems recovering.

We do, however, have £72 of debts relating to the Wessex event in 2020 that despite chasing have not been recovered. This event happened immediately before lockdown and invoices were not raised until September 2020 and this delay has hampered our ability to recover funds. I will seek formal approval to write these off when compiling the accounts if we have no further progress.

I have now created a debtor blacklist of invoices written off since 2016 and this is below, anonymised. It shows that no debts raised since we introduced our accounting system in 2018 have been written off.
