



- Considering absolute return and risk across the whole portfolio


What Can You Invest In?

- Schools, hospitals, roads, airports, power and water assets
- Substantial variation in return profile
- Lower risk, lower return:
- Operational, availability based payment, term financed
- Higher risk, higher return:
- Under construction, demand based payment, face refinancing risk


