1. Fair Deal II Oct 2013

- Fair Deal I Jun '99: "broadly comparable scheme" used
- Need: TUPE doesn't protect "core" pension scheme rights
- UK Policy Aim: protection when central government outsources functions and transfers staff to private sector
- England & Wales: Participation Agreement should allow continued membership of pre-transfer Scheme
- Scotland: membership offered, but policy non-statutory



2. IORP II Directive Mar 2014

- IORP I Jun 2003: PA04 helped EU-wide OPS regulation
- UK Policy: HMG agreed in that OPS Regs should reflect Directive, and with Unison QC that IORP I applied to LGPS
- England & Wales: 31 Dec 16 deadline on OPS minimum governance standard, disclosure and member protection
- Scotland: likely to be similar to E&W, unless independent



3A. Law Commission Report (E&W) Apr 2014

- Backgound: Kay's concern on investment intermediaries between member and investee, short-termism
- LC Focus: adequacy of current fiduciary duties, member interests v. employer, ethical, ESG interests
- Pension Focus: chosen due to length of chain between member and investee
- England & Wales: LC said review LGPS Regs to (1) reflect IORP member best interests req, (2) alter quarterly measures
- Scotland: UK-wide legislation likely, unless carve-out for independence



3B. Law Commission Report (Scotland) Aug 2014

- Backgound: Draft Bill to replace all Scots trust legislation, except charitable and public trusts, after work with E&W LC
- SLC Focus: to update law to service private, commercial and cross-jurisdictional interests
- Pension Focus: recommendation for remedy where trustee has failed in exercise of fiduciary power
- LGPS: Not mentioned, so new law may apply only to private sector OPSs



4. LGPS Collaboration – SAB Response Jul 2014

- Origin: DCLG May 14 consultation on LGPS Reform:
 Opportunities for Collaboration, Cost Savings & Efficiencies
- England & Wales SAB: suggest (1) "explain or comply" rather than no active investment management, (2) CIVs positive, but infrastructure co-investment, joint committees and other collaborations also good
- Scotland: no reason for collaborations between 11 AAs not to increase, both for admin functions and making investment



5. LGPS Governance Aug 2014

- Origin: Public Service Pensions Act 2013
- England & Wales SAB: changes (1) expanded role for TPR

 see draft Code of Practice Dec 2013, (2) Shadow Scheme
 Advisory Board until Apr 2015, (3) TPR "quick guides" to public service pension boards and their members Jul 2014
- Scotland: (1) TPR framework, (2) SPPA making plans with SLOGPAG, (3) Scottish SAB expected + local boards, (4) draft Regs expected Oct 2014, (5) implementation Apr 2015

6. LGPS Scotland (Accruals) Apr 2015

- LGPS (Scotland) Regs: replaces 2008 Regs, save for Transitional Regs protecting rights under 4 earlier versions
- Accrual: 1/49th of CARE not 1/60th FPS
- Accounts: at least one account per member
- Contributions: tiered by salary 5.5% up to 10.1% (pre-tax)
- Contribution Flexibility: new 50:50 option
- Rule of 85: transitional protection to 2020 despite abolition
- Future Costs: new mechanism involving trade unions, employers and government



7. LGPS Scotland (Exits) Apr 2015

- Flexibility in DC Schemes: 2013 Budget changes due from Apr 2015
- Transfers from LGPS: exodus likely to access flexibilities?
- UK Policy Aim: shake-up of annuity and charging market relevance to LGPS?
- England & Wales: different trends in Scotland?



8. NHS Pension Scheme Apr 2015

- Expansion of Direction Status: differences from admission agreement arrangements
- UK Policy Aim: replacement of broad comparability with private sector participation in public sector schemes, even though unfunded
- Scotland: NHS Regs 2008 & 2011 likely effect and relationship with LGPS from 2015



9. LGPS Advisory Board Apr 2015

- Legislation: PSPA 2013 + SI/SSI Regs + TPR framework
- Boards: National and local latter based on 101 LGPS Admin Authorities (11 in Scotland)
- UK Policy Aim: cost efficiencies and sharing of services and investment vehicles, convergence with private sector governance envisaged via IORP II compliance
- Scotland: opportunities from clarification of duties owed to members / employers, but revolution unlikely?



10. Independence / Devolution

- Merger of 11 Scottish AAs: Pathfinder revisiting unlikely?
- Substance: £20bn+ fund creates fund for accelerated investment in Scottish housing, infrastructure, etc or still too small to make major changes without reciprocal investments?
- **Governance:** How tightly to define members' and beneficiaries' interests? When are employers' interests the same as members' interests?
- Interim: How much more can be done using current UK-wide powers, without waiting?
