Public Service Pensions Bill

- Queen's Speech 12 May
- Public Service Pensions Bill
- Reform public service pensions in line with the recommendations of the Independent Public Service Pensions Commission



Public Service Pensions Bill

- Issued 13 September 2012
- Implementation 2013
- £65B savings over 50 years
- Closure of current schemes
- Creation of new schemes



Public Service Pensions Bill

- Capping costs
- Valuations Role of HM Treasury
- Governance
 - Scheme Manager
 - Pensions Board
- Access for private sector



Fair Deal Update

- Statement in LGPS Heads of Agreement
 - "Where scheme members are outsourced they will be able to stay in the scheme on first and subsequent transfers (currently this is a choice for the new employer)."
- Ministerial Statement July 2012
- Public Service Pensions Bill
- Consultation on new guidance expected
- Continued protection for employees



LGPS (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2012

LGPS (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2012 – Auto Enrolment

- Auto enrolment changes:
 - all eligible employees under Part 1 schedule 2 to be automatically enrolled in LGPS when employment commences (unless contract less than 3 months)
 - eligible employee of admission bodies designated by employer to become active member of LGPS on effective date of designation (unless contract less than 3 months)



LGPS (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2012 – Auto Enrolment

- Other issues:
 - no linkage to staging date
 - opt out provisions
 - contracts of less than 3 months postponement notice!



LGPS (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2012 – Admission Bodies

- New admission agreements after 1 October 2012
- Community <u>and</u> transferee agreements
- Need separate admission agreements for each contract – no `umbrella' agreements
- Risk self-assessment by <u>admission body</u> (to satisfaction of administering authority/scheme employer)



LGPS (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2012 – Admission Bodies

- Alternative forms of security allowed instead of bond – parent company guarantee
- Funds need to update standard admission agreement precedents



LGPS (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2012 – Other Changes

- Valuation powers for exiting scheme employers
- Update discretionary policy statements



Recent Case Law

- Data Protection
- Pensions Ombudsman
 - Hercberg v Wolverhampton City Council
 - Parry v Bridgend County Borough Council
 - Cooper v West Yorkshire Police



Data Protection - reminder

- Care needed if using external firms to process data
- As 'data controller' need to ensure compliance with DPA requirements and also for processors
- Need contractual agreement



Data Protection



- LGPS fund outsourced digitalisation of member records
- Member records found by member of public on overflowing recycling bank
- Over 800 files deposited
- Contained personal and financial data



Protecting member data



- Fund failed to chose contractor providing sufficient DPA guarantees
- No regular monitoring to ensure compliance
- No contract between Fund and contractor
- Serious breach fined <u>£250,000!</u>
